Notable Events for 2022:

2022 gross revenue exceeded 2021 by approximately \$2,000; however, 2022 expenditures surpassed 2021 by approximately \$10,300, so SCR's net loss for 2022 is about \$8,300 more than for 2021.

The primary factors affecting financial results were:

lower 2022 Seminar profits (post-Covid inflation!) - but still better than budgeted! increase in Education expenses (chapter benefits, GCC, online course) - a good thing! and increase in Travel and Meetings expenses

The 2022 Opportunity Drawing fundraiser paid for itself, for 2.3 years!

For 2022, all major expenses categories were under-budget; a few line items were over-budget, most by insignificant amounts. Notable exception: Meeting Rooms/Expenses

Other expense line items appear to be significantly over-budget, but are "artificially" over due to timing differences (Seminar 2024 loan, prepayment of 2023 mid-year meeting venue) or are volume-driven with offsetting revenue for a large portion of the expense (online course, GCCs)

Of 14 small chapters (<30 primary/non-SCR plural), 6 applied and received full or partial benefit

Non-budgeted expenses of \$418.07 total incurred to pay for SCR banner finishing, to purchase RD gift in 2022 and 2023 to Gold Thread Award winners, and for bank charges (checks order)
